Introducing a new tax-free system!

Tax-free Shops (Consumption Tax Exemption) TF

In order to receive tax exemption, you must make purchases at the same store on the same day totaling the amounts given below:

- 1 Consumable items: minimum ¥5,001 and maximum ¥500,000 (not including tax)
- 2 General items: minimum ¥10,001 (not including tax)
- ※ From May 2016
- Consumable and general items: minimum ¥5,000 (not including tax)
- As for consumable items: maximum ¥500,000 (not including tax)
